### Native Storyteller

**Mike Newland** is a professional Archaeologist from Sonoma State University who is a leader in addressing issues involving cultural heritage and climate change. Mike is a member of the Archaeological Resources Committee of the State Historic Resources Commission and past President of the Society for California Archaeology (SCA). He currently leads the SCA's effort to record California's archaeological sites before they are destroyed by the impacts of climate change. Mike was also appointed to the Society for American Archaeology's (SAA) eight-member Climate Change Task Force where he helps to construct national policy and advises on site identification and the treatment of climate change impacts to significant cultural resources.

**Josh Fryday** is currently the Chief Operating Officer (COO) for NextGen Climate and a Novato City Councilman. NextGen Climate is a San Francisco-based environmental advocacy organization acting politically to prevent climate disaster and promote prosperity for all Americans.
